Hello everyone!

Welcome to a new year at Mountain Peaks. I am so excited to work with you and your amazing kids. This packet outlines our schedule, tuition, curriculum, and expectations. My goal is for us to be a team, so if you have questions, please feel free to call me anytime!



The Schedule: How it Works

We follow the Weber School District Calendar. Our specific school calendar is always available at mtnpeakslearning.com. Remember, students are **required to attend 3 days each week!** We will be in person those three days some weeks and the alternate weeks students will attend an online class provided by me.

- The Block Rotation: We follow a local Junior High A/B schedule.
 - Class is from 9 AM-1 PM when in person
 - "A" Days (In-Person): I teach two lessons per core class (Reading, Writing, Grammar, and Math). Students use remaining class time to start homework.
 - "B" Days (At Home): Students are required to finish all homework as well as log in to attend the online History/Writing/Art class taught by me that is required once a week. I am available for extra help/appointments after 3:00 PM on these days.
 - **Hybrid History & Art:** On weeks where we only meet in person twice, we will have a required online History/Art component. I will video these lessons for you to watch at your own pace. The lessons can be completed anytime during the week but must be finished by Friday for grading purposes.

Parent Responsibilities

Active parental involvement is vital to your child's success in this program.

- Transportation: Drop off and pick up students promptly at scheduled times.
 - At-Home Learning: Supervise independent assignments and homework on non-class days.
 - Communication: Review progress reports and respond to program updates promptly.
 - Legal Compliance: Parents remain responsible for filing any required state homeschool paperwork.

Curriculum & Supplies

I've worked hard to select programs that are effective and cost-efficient.

- Language Arts: *The Good and the Beautiful* (GAB) – All Grades.
 - Math: GAB (Grades K-4); *Saxon Math* (Grades 5-8).
 - History & Art: A special hybrid course in partnership with local artist Jess Cook.
 - Purchasing: Parents will be sent a purchase list for their child's specific grade level once they have signed the school disclosure and paid their start-up fee.

Tuition, Fees, & Refund Policy

- Start-up Fee: \$50 per student (Due with your info packet; covers basic classroom supplies).
- Monthly Tuition: \$400 per student. We will be in school August-May.
- Due Date: Within the first week of each month.
- Payment Methods:
 - Venmo: @Brendy-Saunders
 - Check: Payable to *Valley Academic Solutions* or *Brendy Saunders*
 - Cash: Delivered in person
- *Note: If something comes up, please just text me! I am always happy to work with you.*
- **Refunds:** Materials fees are non-refundable once items have been purchased.

Withdrawal: A 30-day written notice is required to terminate enrollment. Parents are still required to pay 50% of remaining tuition after withdrawal. The remaining amount left of the student's scholarship will be turned over to Odyssey to be used at their discretion.

Health, Safety, and Liability

We prioritize the well-being of every student in our home.

- **Illness:** Keep students home if they have a fever or contagious symptoms.
 - **Medication:** Instructors will not administer medication without written parental consent.
 - **Emergencies:** First aid will be administered for minor injuries; parents are called immediately for emergencies.
 - **Liability:** Parents assume standard liability risks associated with activities inside and outside the home.

- **For Students:** We focus on what respect "looks and sounds like" in a learning environment.
 - **For Parents:** Please help facilitate learning on "B" days to keep your student on track.
 - **Open Door Policy:** You are welcome to visit the school at any time (though I might put you to work! 😊).
 - **Resolving Concerns:** If a problem arises, please contact me privately so we can find a solution together.
